Time to Reflect

"So be careful how you act; these are difficult days. Don't be fools; be wise: make the most of every opportunity you have for doing good." Ephesians 5:15-16 (Living Bible)

As we turned our clocks back in October, I was reminded of the beauty and significance of time in our lives. Just as the seasons change, the rhythm of our days does too. The extra hour invites us to reflect on how we use our time and appreciate the blessings that each moment brings.

In Ephesians 5:15-16 we are encouraged to "*be careful how you act; these are difficult days. Don't be fools; be wise: make the most of every opportunity*". This passage urges us to seize the moments God provides, especially as we have gained an extra hour. Let's think about how we can use this time to deepen our relationship with Him and with one another.

As the clocks have changed, let this serve as a reminder to embrace each moment that God has given us. May we find joy in the time we share together and in our individual journeys of faith.






Prayer Matters

Green your home. Combat climate change and reduce heating costs by identifying and sealing draughts around your home. Find the gaps that let the cold air in and warm air out (think keyholes, letterboxes, cracks around the edges or bottoms of windows and doors, loft hatches, floorboards, etc.) and fix these gaps using the correct materials and online tutorials. Additionally, place foil or radiator panels to reflect heat into your room. Pray for those who might be experiencing the cold this winter.

World Vision staff monitor Joel's wellbeing and currently his health is good.

This year Joel and his family participated in and benefitted from:

- Farming training they can grow more crops that are nutritious for the children, improving their health and income.
- School books and study materials to help Joel with his education.
- Life skills training skills that he can apply to daily challenges.
- Reading and writing workshops Joel has worked hard to improve.
- Hygiene workshop Joel knows how to stay clean and safe from germs so that he doesn't get sick.
